Feyhan Yaşar started her career in 1978 at DYO, one of the Yaşar Group companies. Yaşar served in administrative positions in the fields of finance and administration at Yaşar Group. After Selçuk Yaşar became the Honorary Chair, Feyhan Yaşar took office as Chairperson of Yaşar Holding Board of Directors from 2004 to 2009. Having served at Boards of Directors within various Yaşar Group companies, Feyhan Yaşar served as Vice Chairperson of Yaşar Holding Board of Directors from 2014 to 2021.

As of January 2022, Feyhan Yaşar is the Chair of Yaşar Holding Board of Directors. She also serves for Yaşar Group companies' Boards of Directors.
